## What can my student take?

Students may choose 3 specials included in the price of tuition. Please consider donating for materials or money for material-based classes such as crafting, computers, art, and costuming.

If a student would like to take a 4<sup>th</sup> class, the cost for this class will be \$40 per month. If a student has scholarship money in their account to do so, they may utilize that (\$400 over the course of the year), or a parent can pay out of pocket. This is to cover the cost of the extra teachers we utilize during this time and the extra materials we purchase to have students in more than 3 classes.

Specials Descriptions:

- **Art with Ms. Melanie:** Learn the elements of art: Form, shape, line, design. Includes art vocabulary and creating art from a variety of mediums, both 2D and 3D.
- **Crafting with Ms. Kristen:** Every month create a new craft that will be a giftable work of art. Older kids will learn the elements of wood working in an art setting such as sanding, staining, and wood burning. Younger kids will focus more on painting and design. The best part is many of these could be gifted by your child to beloved friends and relatives at Christmas!
- **Guitar with Ms. Stephanie:** Learn the elements of guitar including playing melodies, chords, and popular songs. Priority is given to seniors who need a performing arts credit, but is open to kids through 8<sup>th</sup> grade who are dedicated to practicing and learning guitar. (If you have access to a guitar, please bring it. Ask around your family. They may have one gathering dust somewhere)
- **PE: Physical Education with Ms. Dawn:** Play outdoor games and experiment with types of sports!
- **Typing with Jayden/Ms. Sue:** Spend a half hour playing fun typing games and learning an important skill at the same time. If you have a laptop, please bring it.
- **Theater with Ms. Jennifer:** Act out scenes from classic literature! Improves reading fluency, confidence, and public speaking. Past classics that have been used include *Peter Pan*, *Anne of Green Gables*, *Pride and Prejudice*, *Little Women*, *A Little Princess*, *Tom Sawyer* and more. (May sometimes involve magic or magical-related beings)
- **Read Aloud Club with Ms. Melanie:** Sit back, relax, and listen to some John Grisham! Our students loved “Theodore Boone, Kid Lawyer” so much this summer, they demanded she keep reading it to them! Come join the excitement and adventure.
- **History Club with Alicia:** Explore history with crafts, videos, and activities.
- **Animal Studies Lab with Ms. Emily:** Students will be specifically completing labs that they were not able to do last year due to coronavirus. Expect more field trips, guest speakers, and fun furry animal friends!
- **Costume Lab with Ms. Jennifer:** Need a cosplay costume or Halloween costume? The sky’s the limit with Ms. Jen! She will help students plan, purchase, and create costumes and props for any purpose! First semester only, most likely.
- **Coding with Jayden/Ms. Sue:** Jayden will be leading a 45-minute class using “An Hour of Code” and “Bit Box coding.” Open to 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> graders. Students can also get some coding programs on their tablets to practice on during the week.
- **Cheerleading with Ms. Stacey:** Fridays only w/ online videos to practice at home. Depending on interest, we may split into two groups.
- **Sign language with Ms. Stacey:** Fridays only w/practices to do on their own time.
- **Project Lab:** Fridays only – come and work on class projects, or do one for fun.
- **FLVS Lab:** Fridays only – Come and get help with your FLVS classes!
